

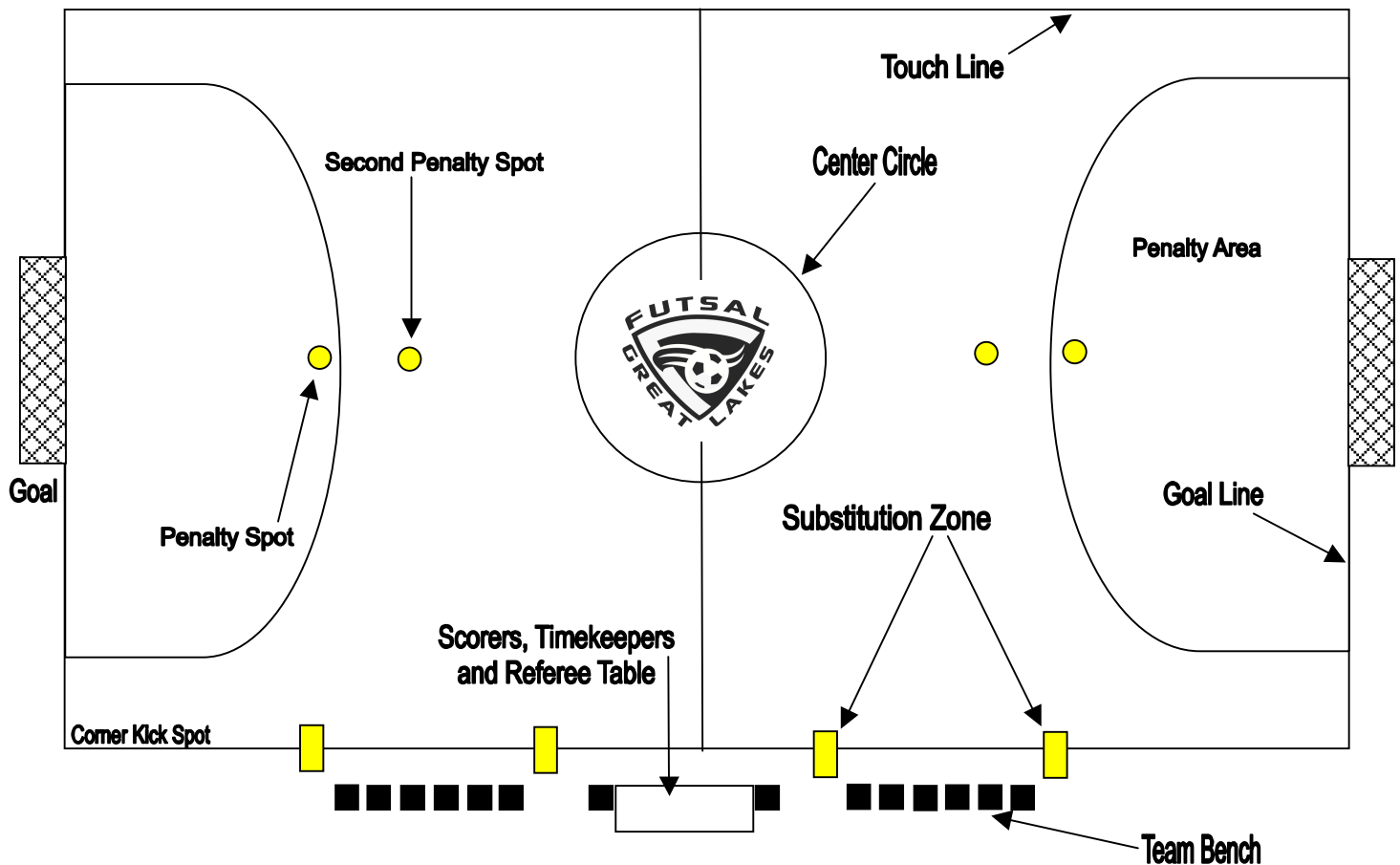

Great Lakes Futsal Leagues. House Rules. Instructions. Information.

1. Players & Coach on bench only. Coach of each team designates an adult to be the Scorer for the team. Scorer shall NOT coach.
2. Scorer from each team sits at scorer's table to: A. Record goals/fouls. B. Work the clock/scoreboard. Switch duties at halftime.
3. Keep player bags, water bottles and balls off court and away from bench. Place against wall or net at the end of your bench.
4. Teams warm-Up 3 minutes on respective sides of field. Bring water to bench. Keep liquids OFF of court.
5. Two, 25 minute halves, running time. 3 minute halftime. Kickoff must go forward as in outdoor soccer.
6. Referee will be paid \$10 per team, address captains and coaches & answer any questions prior to games.
7. Kick-in's instead of throw-in's. Ball on line and foot touching or behind line. 4 second's allotted for all restarts.
8. Substitutions are made anytime (on-the-fly) within substitution ZONE designated by yellow lines in front of bench.
9. NO slide tackling, NO contact prior to receiving ball, AND same fouls as outdoor soccer apply.
10. Every foul AFTER 5th team foul in a half results in penalty kick from 2nd penalty spot being awarded.
11. One :45 second timeout allowed per team each half.
12. 'Goal-Throw' taken instead of goal kick, 4 second's to release ball, Cannot punt ball (from a goal clearance) or score directly from a throw.
13. Goalkeeper MAY NOT put ball to his/her feet off of goal throw but MAY after a save during regular play.
14. Goalkeeper may use feet only one time per team possession unless:
 - a. Ball Enters Opposing Half OR
 - b. Ball Goes Out of Bounds OR
 - c. Ball is Touched by Opponent
 - d. This possession may consist of multiple touches during the 4 second allotted time to distribute or move over mid-court.
15. COMPLETED game-card, attested to and signed by BOTH coaches is to be dropped into collection box at end of game.
